

ORDINANCE NO. 70-1 (A)

The Town Board of the Town of Walworth, Walworth County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 70-1 of said Town of Walworth is amended and changed and added to as follows:

A. Section 2 of said Ordinance is renumbered Section 4, and Section 3 is renumbered Section 5.

B. A new Section 2 shall be added to said Ordinance which shall read as follows:

"Section 2. Highways and Roads to be kept free from dirt, manure and crop refuse and debris. No person shall drop or deposit or cause to be dropped or deposited any dirt, gravel, manure, crop refuse or debris upon the public roads in the Town of Walworth without removing same within 6 hours.

The combined action and nonaction of dropping and not removing in time shall be the violation of this ordinance. If the person or persons violating this Section are employees, their employer shall be jointly responsible for the violation and forfeiture."

C. A new Section 3 shall be added to said Ordinance which shall read as follows:

"Section 3. Damage to Highways by Machinery. The operator and owner of any machinery or equipment that damages the surface of any Public Highway in the Town of Walworth shall be responsible to repair same in a way satisfactory to the Town Board within two weeks from said damage. If not so repaired, the Town Board may do so and collect the costs against the violators, or declare a violation of this Ordinance."

D. Ordinance 70-1 as amended by Ordinance 70-1 (A) is hereby designated Ordinance No. 71-1, and shall read as follows:

ORDINANCE 71-1

The Town Board of the Town of Walworth, Walworth County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Littering Prohibited. No person shall throw or drop or deposit any glass, rubbish, bottles, paper, cans, garbage, waste, filth or other litter upon the streets, alleys, highways, public parks, tree banks of highways, or any other property owned by the Town of Walworth or property which the Town of Walworth controls or upon any surface of any body of water within the Town of Walworth or upon any private property in the Town of Walworth.

Section 2. Highways and Roads to be Kept Free From Dirt, Manure and Crop Refuse and Debris. No person shall drop or deposit or cause to be dropped or deposited any dirt, gravel, manure, crop refuse or debris upon the public roads in the Town of Walworth without removing same within six hours.

The combined action and non-action of dropping and not removing in time shall be the violation of this ordinance. If the person or persons violating this Section are employees, their employer shall be jointly responsible for the violation and forfeiture.

Section 3. Damage to Highways by Machinery. The operator and owner of any machinery or equipment that damages the surface of any Public Highway in the Town of Walworth shall be responsible to repair same in a way satisfactory to the Town Board within two weeks from said damage. If not so repaired, the Town Board may do so and collect the costs against the violators, or declare a violation of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Any person who violates this ordinance shall forfeit to the Town of Walworth not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$200.00 for the first offense and not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$200.00 for any subsequent offense occurring in the same year with the actual forfeiture to be decided by the trial court.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after adoption and publication as required by law.
